For me, the beginning of this year has been steeped in the beginning of the Bible. I, along with others in our church, embarked on an Immerse reading plan, reading from Genesis to Deuteronomy in January and February. Many of these foundational stories help us establish who God is and who we are. As we end Deuteronomy, the people are given a choice:

"Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live!" - Deut. 30:19b

Choosing life feels like it would be an easy choice. When reading a book about transforming our churches in light of the changing realities in our communities, Todd Bolsinger tells us that change isn't just hard; Change is loss. He says, in a study of those who were faced with life and death choices—stop drinking or you will die, stop smoking or you will die, change your diet now or you will die, nearly 90% choose to risk death.

Lent is often a time of reflection where we consider our choices, and how lifeless they are without Christ and the hope of the resurrection. What are the ways that we are trying to do things on our own or otherwise making choices that are killing us. This is what we are going to explore in our Lenten series: Dying to Live. I hope you will choose to join us, starting at our Ash Wednesday service at 4pm on March 5.

I am praying that this would be a meaningful and life-giving season for us all.

Nehemiah Action Mon, March 31st


